


Welcome Future First Grade Students and Families!

We separated the lists so you can see that some items are going to be shared, while others will be used for just your child. We want to keep each student safe. Thanks in advance for your willingness to donate to our first grade classrooms!



Individual Materials

You can bring these materials to school at Open House or on the first day and we will put a label with your child's name on them (Just be sure your child's name is on the bag they bring in.)

- Backpack (Please no wheels...They don't fit in the lockers.)
- 3 - 2 Pocket Folders (Home folder) (Believe it or not, they can be hard to find later in the year! Have them pick the one they want to start the year with and send it to school on the first day! Keep the other 2 at home for use when they need a new one!)
- Earbuds for the iPad (put in a snack size bag to fit in pencil box)
- Leak-proof Water Bottle
- 24 ct. CRAYOLA Crayons
- 12 ct. CRAYOLA Colored Pencils
- FISKARS pointed scissors
- Black EXPO Marker
- ELMERS glue stick
- #2 TICONDEROGA Pencils
- Pencil Box - (This is for your child's own supplies: crayons, scissors, pencil, and colored pencils. Please be sure that it does not have a zipper and it is no larger than 8 x 6.)

Extra Materials

(These are extras for students who don't have supplies or as we run out throughout the year.)

- Pink block erasers
- ELMERS Glue Sticks
